All applicants must be fluent in verbal and written English.

STEP 4: If approved to move forward, we grant Conditional Acceptance. You will be given the Student Handbook and other required forms that you will need to read, agree to, sign and return to Student Services

STEP 5: After the forms have been received, we offer Formal Acceptance into the Panchakarma Therapist Training Program

- Resume or CV
- 2 Professional Reference Letters (from people who know you in professional (including volunteer) or academic settings. These may not be from family members.
- Proof of minimum Ayurvedic Health Counselor Education (Certificate or Transcript noting completion of program)
